The following schedule is for the Full Marching Band – Colorguard included:

10:50am – Report to OHS (Already wearing your green marching shirt, mesh/nylon shorts, black socks, black Dinkles, white gloves)

11:00am – Rehearsal in the stadium

12:30pm – Load equipment trailers and truck

12:45pm – Lunch – Pizza/Chips/Cookie/Drink

1:15pm – Change into MB uniform

1:45pm – Depart for Fayette County High School

3:00pm - Arrive at show site – Unload and prepare for warm-up

4:00pm – Warm-up

4:45pm – OHS Marching Mustangs Perform in Competition

5:30pm – Prelims Awards Ceremony –

6:00pm – Dinner Break – (Bring Money for Concession Stand!!!!)

** If we do not make Finals we will still stay and watch the other bands. Please be prepared to wear warm clothing in the stands!

** If we do make Finals then we will prepare for the finals performance

7:30pm – Finals Performances Begin

10:00pm – Finals Awards

11:00pm – Depart for Ola High School

12:15am – Arrive back at OHS

***CHAPERONES AND EQUIPMENT/STAFF:** Everyone helping with the band will receive a hand stamp upon arrival. (3) Chaperones per bus. Please help us to respect those who are working. Gate admission for spectators is \$7 for adults and \$3 for children under 12.

***TAILGATING/COOKOUTS/COOLERS:** This is absolutely prohibited. No grills will be allowed on the parking lot, and no coolers will be allowed in the stadium. There will be a concession area in the parking lot where the buses park.

***SEATING:** We have mapped out a seating chart for your band and your chaperones. We also will have nametags for your chaperones so they can easily be identified for entrance into the gate.

***PARKING:** There is special parking area for the buses and designated parking for equipment trucks and spectators.

VIDEO AND PHOTOGRAPHS:** A professional photographer will be available who will supply packets to you to order photographs. ***WE APOLOGIZE, BUT NO VIDEO EQUIPMENT WILL BE ALLOWED THIS YEAR.

***SMOKING:** We have a tobacco free campus.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

NO BUSES WILL BE ADMITTED FROM HOOD AVENUE

NO TRUCKS ALLOWED ON THE TRACK...ONLY GATORS OR GOLF CARTS FOR PIT EQUIPMENT.

For those who are not familiar with the location of Fayette County HS, here are directions.

From I-285 go south until you get to I-75 South and immediately take the exit ramp onto GA Hwy 85 (Columbus & Riverdale.) Hwy 85 will take you through Riverdale and into Fayetteville. In Fayetteville, watch for Checkers and a BP Service Station on the right. Continue on Hwy 85 until you get to the Fayetteville Courthouse Square (intersection of Hwy 54.) Turn right on Hwy 54 and continue to the first street on the right, Tiger Trail. Turn right on Tiger Trail. Go through the stop sign (Lafayette Ave.) then make an immediate left into the bus parking lot. Equipment trucks will park in the lot to the immediate right past Lafayette Ave. Your guide will meet you in the parking lot.

From the North, take I-75 south through Atlanta. As you go under I-285 watch for GA Hwy 85 and immediately take the exit ramp onto GA Hwy 85 (Columbus & Riverdale.) Hwy 85 will take you through Riverdale and into Fayetteville. In Fayetteville, watch for Checkers and a BP Service Station on the right. Continue on Hwy 85 until you get to the Fayetteville Courthouse Square (intersection of Hwy 54.) Turn right on Hwy 54 and continue to the first street on the right, Tiger Trail. Turn right on Tiger Trail. Go through the stop sign (Lafayette Ave.) then make an immediate left into the bus parking lot. Equipment trucks will park in the lot to the immediate right past Lafayette Ave. Your guide will meet you in the parking lot.

From Peachtree City...travel east on GA Hwy 54 toward Fayetteville. As you enter the outskirts of Fayetteville you will see a large sign that says "Welcome to Fayetteville." After the sign get into the left lane and turn at the first left, Tiger Trail. Tiger Trail will take you across Hwy 54 (going the other direction.) Continue to the stop sign (Lafayette Ave.) then after the stop sign make an immediate left into the bus parking lot. Equipment trucks will park in the lot to the immediate right past Lafayette Ave. Your guide will meet you in the parking lot.

From Jonesboro...travel west on GA Hwy 54 toward Fayetteville. As you enter Fayetteville go past the courthouse and continue on Hwy 54 to the first right (Tiger Trail.) Turn right on Tiger Trail. Go through the stop sign (Lafayette Ave.) then make an immediate left into the bus parking lot. Equipment trucks will park in the lot to the immediate right past Lafayette Ave. Your guide will meet you in the parking lot.
