**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** Ensembles at Ola High School will provide students with in-depth knowledge of their instruments, other instruments, elements of music, proper fundamentals of breathing and posture, ability-appropriate band literature, and rehearsal techniques. Special emphasis will be placed on developing musicianship and ensemble responsibility through performance in a variety of settings. The students will also become life-long learners of music and be able to enjoy it through-out their adult life. **This is a yearlong course.**

Classroom attendance will be handled in accordance with Henry County Schools and Ola High School Policy.

*DRESS REHEARSAL POLICY – students who do not attend class the day of a concert will not be permitted to perform on that concert. This day is considered the dress rehearsal for that performance and students must be present for final information and reminders.*

**TARDY POLICY:** Students not in the band room (on the band room carpet) will be counted tardy. Any student who misses more than one-half of any class is considered absent from that class. Students not in their seat and fully prepared to begin class 3 minutes after the tardy bell will be considered late to rehearsal and will not earn their participation points. Tardies will result in a student not receiving their daily participation points.

**CELL PHONES:** Students **ARE NOT** allowed to have access to their phones during class time. Per the Administration at Ola High School, students are required to store their phone in the cell phone cady every day.

<p><b>100 points</b> - Pencil checks, music checks (<i>including measures numbered for concert music</i>) and any other assignment deemed necessary by the instructor.</p> <p><b>200 points</b> Playing quizzes, after school rehearsals and any other assignment deemed necessary by the instructor.</p> <p><b>300 points</b> - Performances and any other assignment deemed necessary by the instructor.</p>	<p><b>Daily Grade:</b> Students will earn 20 point per day and receive a grade the last day of each week.</p> <p><i>Reasons a student will not earn their daily points: Unexcused absences, No pencil, no music, no instrument, tardy to class, disruption to the rehearsal, or not properly cleaning up after a rehearsal.</i></p> <p>Any other assignments deemed necessary by the instructor.</p>	<p>Final semester exam will count as 20% of each student's final average.</p> <p>Playing, written, or a combination of the two.</p> <p>Exams are to be taken on the assigned day and not early.</p> <p><b>FINALS WILL BE ADMINISTERED IN ACCORDANCE WITH OLA HIGH SCHOOL PROCEDURES.</b></p>

**CONCERT ATTIRE:** School designated tuxedos, dresses, and accessories are required for all performances. Additional information will be provided within the first few weeks of school. Students will not be permitted to perform unless in the correct attire. Make up assignments will not be provided for those refusing to follow the expectations of the program.

**RESTROOM AND HALL PASSES:** Only one student will be allowed to use the restroom at a time. Each class is only 50 minutes and students will be expected to use the restroom on their way to the band room to avoid rehearsal disruptions. When a student needs to go to the restroom, they **MUST** ask for permission to leave the room. The same student will not be permitted to leave the room every day. Going to the restroom is for emergencies only. Hall Passes will not be written to go to another teacher, front office, media center, or the school store. If there is an emergency, we will handle that on a one-on-one basis.

### NEEDED MATERIALS:

- Instrument (in proper working order) and other accessories
  - Brass- Valve Oil, Slide Grease, Cleaning supplies, and Proper Mouthpiece
  - Woodwinds- Cork Grease, Ongoing supply of at least 4 reeds, and Swab
  - Percussion – drum pad and SD1's snare sticks.
- Korg Tuner and Mic Clip (Winds Students Only)
  - Korg CA1 (chromatic tuner)
  - Korg TM50C (tuner/metronome combo)
  - Korg Tuner Mic Clip (CM300)
- Pencil
- Music Folder will be provided
- Method Book will be provided

**SCHOOL OWNED INSTRUMENTS:** School owned instruments will be checked out and non-marching band members will be required to pay a one-time fee of \$75 for the school year made payable online only.

**Please understand that there is a limited supply of instruments.**

Students will be responsible for adhering to the schedule. Please schedule all appointments on non-rehearsal/concert days. It is imperative to the success of the program that we have 100% attendance at all rehearsals. PLEASE BE REMINDED THAT BAND IS CO-CURRICULAR, MEANING A GRADE IS ASSIGNED TO ALL EVENTS ON THIS SYLLABUS.
