1:09pm	Body Warm-up (<i>beginning dance hit, dancer lift, work with dancers hit while other work on body while airing equipment</i>)
1:16pm	Transition to Equipment
1:19pm	Equipment Warm-up

1:35pm	PERFORMANCE TIME (SHOW TIME!!!)
1:46pm	Immediately after the show we QUICKLY meet out of the way, refold the floor, then reload the trailer as needed.
1:53pm	Members to stands to watch retreat - LEADERSHIP TO STAGING AREA FOR RETREAT
2:03pm	AWARDS
2:25pm	IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING AWARDS GROUP PICTURE - then you will go to the hallway to change and return uniforms.

CHECK IN:

At least 1 ½ hours before your performance time at the VRHS Library beside the semi-circle bus lane. Each unit will receive armbands for marching members plus 8 extras. Please declare the number of marching members that you have with you that day. If more than 8 extras are needed, they must be purchased via GoFan for \$15.00 each.

SOUND TESTING:

1 hour before the show and during breaks at the discretion of the sound tech.

Parents and visitors are not permitted in the hallway area prior to performances.

JUDGE COMMENTARY:

You may listen to your judge commentary after your unit's performance as soon as you receive a notification text from CompetitionSuite. Be sure that your phone number is registered before the show so that you will be able to receive the text.

BACKSIDE SEATING:

Performers should sit on the back side of the gym before and after their performance.

RETREAT:

There will be a retreat after SRA Round 1 at 2:03pm.

CRITIQUE:

Critique will be offered at this contest. Signup will open at 9:00 am on Wednesday, Jan. 14. Critique will take place in the chorus room of the fine arts building

Best Practices for Audience & Performer Etiquette

Tips for a safe, respectful, and fun show day!


DOs

- **Arrive early & buy tickets ahead of time** – reduce stress and avoid missing performances
- **Support ALL performers** – every group deserves respect for their hard work
- **Be mindful of your words and surroundings** – comments travel farther than you think
- **Be present during performances** – focus and attention create a better experience for everyone
- **Respect shared spaces** – warm-ups, hallways, and seating are used by many groups
- **Follow staff and volunteer directions** – they help keep the event safe and on schedule
- **Pick up trash and keep your belongings close** – leave it better than you found it
- **Visit the vendors and merch booths** – support the performers' community and local programs


DON'Ts

- **Do not enter or exit the stands during a performance** – this is a distraction to the performers and judges.
- **No flash photography** – it is distracting and a safety concern for performers on the floor.
- **No video recording** – due to copyright laws, video recording is strictly prohibited at all SAPA events.
- **Talk during performances** – even quiet conversations can be distracting.
- **Cheer excessively or aggressively** – applause is encouraged, but over-cheering can become a distraction.
- **Make negative comments about any group** – performers and families may be nearby.
- **Disrupt warm-ups or block hallways/exits** – groups need focus and clear pathways.








No obstructions, overhangs, basketball goals, etc.
